

# HOME PRODUCT DISPOSAL GUIDE

Meaning Of Letter  
 CS - Clean Sweep or county-based hazardous waste disposal program.

E - Evaporate small amounts of solvents if feasible (open air, away from flame or pets) or dispose of through "Clean Sweep" program.

D - Dispose down drain or share with friends.

L - Trash collection with special wrapping to clay-lined, DNR approved landfill. Wrap container in absorbent material such as newspaper and cover with a plastic bag. Latex and oil base paints should be opened and allowed to harden before disposal.

R - Antifreeze and paint thinner can be reused. Filter product and use again.
